TOURNAMENT RULES

Anglers of any age may enter this tournament. However, only anglers over
the age of fifty on each vessel will be eligible for point scoring, trophies or
prizes. Any class tackle may be used. No more than fifteen feet of leader
is permitted and the angler, captain or mate must touch the leader to
constitute a release. The use of non-offset circle hooks is mandatory. No
live bait chumming allowed. Fishing boundaries are Molasses Reef light
to the east and Tennessee Reef light to the west. Other than bait catching,
fishing in sanctuary preservation areas (SPA's) is not permitted. All sailfish
hook-ups and releases must be reported to the committee boat and only
a registered angler can hook up and fight a fish. This is a boat tournament
and the boat catching and releasing the most sailfish first shall be deemed
the winner. VHF channel '69' is the committee boat channel.
